- Police Report

 - We need to have a Type 11 permit from DEP. The size of the bridge can remain the same. We will not be required to expand the size of the bridge. Andy provided us with a quote to begin the next level.

- COSTARS Electricity
 - Currently we receive electricity with Direct Energy through PP&L. Penn State offers a COSTARS an electricity procurement program. This would be an excellent way to save some money. We can't proceed until closer to October since we are under contract with Direct Energy until OCT2025. This won't take effect until next year but Tom will begin the enrollment process, so we are ready to proceed.
- Internal Administrative Procedures
 - Tom has developed some internal administrative procedures. The Board of Supervisors was asked to review and suggest any recommendations, so we are ready to approve it at the next meeting on 03MAR2025.

Zoning Permits

- There were some discrepancies on Larry Frace's website with the forms found under Briar Creek Township to get applications for permits. Tom cleaned up those issues and made them the same format. He also added Briar Creek Townships fee schedule to Larry's website. Larry approved all the forms, and this will allow the process to run more effectively on his website.
- House Bill Number 308
 - OSHA standards were approved last week and moved forward to a full house vote. Tom reached out to our State Representative letting him know that we respect the safety of the people, however, it's not going to be best for small municipalities, especially for fire
